6. New Business
  - a. BWA Monthly Walks  
The next walk will be August 10<sup>th</sup> at 9:30am, led by Louise Goodwin and Bill Liswell. The route will be from the Percy Cook trail to the Hop River trail, up Lake Road, across the dam, returning to the Town Hall via School Street. Bill will write up a press release for the Rivereast, and post info on the Bike Walk Andover Facebook page. Still need hosts for October 12<sup>th</sup> and November 9<sup>th</sup>.
  - b. Safety signage on trails for EMT Dispatch response  
The Bolton Fire Department contacted Eric Anderson with concerns shared by Andover and Coventry Fire departments: accidents that occur on the Hop River Trail cannot be located and responded to quickly. Under discussion is installing posts every ¼ mile, with the mileage and a town abbreviation (ex: AN for Andover) on each post. Maps would be created and distributed to safety personnel with post locations. As approval is required by DEEP for the posts, the towns will coordinate and create a proposal.

- c. Efforts for a safer Rte 316 pathway, spearheaded by Ed Sarisley  
Ed will canvas homeowners on Rte 316 this summer with the proposal
