We, the Olde Andover Burying Ground Committee, adopt as our purpose to promote restore, and sustain the historic cemetery at Lower Cider (Eastern) Mill and Hebron Roads, to be known as “The Olde Andover Burying Ground”, so that the memories, stories, and lives of the people buried here are honored.

The Committee was formed on October 15, 2015, in the Town of Andover, CT and was adopted as a committee of the Town of Andover, CT by its Board of Selectmen on November 4, 2015. This committee is comprised of seven voting members approved by the Board of Selectmen for a two-year term starting December 2, 2015, and, in the future, every two years starting July 1, 2016.

Goals of the Olde Andover Burying Ground Committee:

Consider joining our efforts as a volunteer!

1. To promote ongoing community interest, involvement, and care through educational and walk through programs. Comprehensive preservation; specifically to:

- Identify and research marked and unmarked graves.
- Identify as many veteran graves as possible so that flags can be properly placed.
- Repair, refurbish, and restore, with the support of experts in the field, as many stone markers as possible.
- Study and implement restoration of the eastern slope to prevent any further damage to graves on the slope.
- Repair and maintenance of the bordering stone walls and entrance walkway.
- Establish a comprehensive protection and improvement plan to sustain and embellish the historical character of the cemetery.
- Conserve and develop the peaceful setting and natural beauty of the cemetery for visitors.



2. Promote continued research to further uncover the history of the cemetery and of those buried there.

3. Design and place a permanent cemetery marker.

4. Seeks grants and other public support that provide funds to accomplish our goals with town government support.

5. Project and event committees can be appointed by the committee and comprised of volunteers, and is not limited to committee members.
