1. Call to Order: Called to order at 10:00 a.m.

2. Pledge of Allegiance: Recited

3. Appeals:

- 3.1 Louise Goodwin Appeal for Real Estate Assessment. Motion by Georgette, 2nd by Alan to leave assessment as is. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
- 3.2 Darryl and Gretchen Stein Appeal for Real Estate Assessment. Applicants provided 2 inspection reports and CCROG guidelines (Capitol RegionCouncil of Governments)- for crumbling foundation. Motion made by Georgette, 2nd Linda, to reduce dwelling assessment 75% from \$124,500 to \$31,133. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
- 3.3 Janusz and Agnieszka Jandzinski Appeal for Real Estate Assessment. Applicants provided inspection report citing termite and water damage, Among other things including probable asbestos in flooring tiles & glue.' Motion made by Georgette to reduce assessment of house from \$101,900 To \$70,000, 2nd by Alan. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
- 3.4 Stephen King Appeal for Personal Property 19PP09. Motion by Alan, 2nd by Linda, to reduce equipment assessment to \$825 from \$3760, reducing 25% penalty to \$206. Motion passed unanimously.
- 4. Remaining decisions made from prior hearing as follows:
 - 4.1 Donald Bunce Personal Property- he produced Personal Property report and tax bill from Coventry for Lull Fork Lift on his property that's not his. Motion made by Georgette, 2nd by Alan to reduce assessment from \$46,550 back to \$10,500 as in prior years. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
 - 4.2 Covell property- Georgette made a motion to correct error in last week's Minutes, 2nd by Linda. The Appraisal amount should have been worded "from \$482,100 to \$445,100". \$100 on both amounts were omitted. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
 - 4.3 Donald Symonds Georgette made a motion to change the decision from last week to making no changes. The motion failed to get a 2nd so last week's motion remains. That is, the assessment for furn/fix/eqp=\$400 and 25% penalty=\$100. Note: We attempted to lower the amount he would pay to \$100 but failed to achieve that goal, forgetting the mil rate factor.

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- 4.4 Stephanie Apatow Personal Property Appeal Motion by Georgette, 2nd by Linda to make no change. Motion passed By unanimous vote.
- 5. Alan made a motion to elect Georgette as permanent chairman, 2nd by Linda. Motion passed 2-0 with Georgette abstaining.
