  - B) Roof Leak On 10/25 Chief was advised by cleaning people that there was a leek. After investigation leaned it has been leaking for a while, but was drying up before anyone noticed it. Chief checked the roof and found where the leek was coming from. If roof cannot be repaired before winter, then the area needs to be protected prior to winter. May need to remove the air conditioning units to protect the area.
  - C) Crake Sealing Parking Lot Town is going to crack seal the lower level parking of the school and will crake seal the fire departments parking lot at no cost to the Fire Commission. The sealing would be done on a Saturday since the Town Office needs to park there during the week. Date to be provided

Commission Chair advised that the new Community Room will be using <u>propane</u> heat and they are thinking about putting in a large generator that will work for the Community Room, Town Office and Fire Dept. They would be putting in two (2) 1,000 gallon tanks and would like to <u>connect all tanks</u> – including Fire Departments together so if Town was without power for a long time they can use all the available propane to power the generator. This is just advisement nothing is confirmed to be done.
