6 Approval of 4/1/2019 Minutes: Motion to accept the April 1, 2019 minutes as presented.

Motioned by C. Dowling 2nd by G. Wright APPROVED BY ALL

7 Financial Report: A) Treasurer - \$42,087.27 in check book until additional bills were paid since

meeting was changed. Amount is now closer to \$30,000 +- in check book

Motion to accept the Treasurers Report as presented Motioned by G. Wright 2nd by C. Dowling APPROVED BY AL

8 Building and Grounds: A) Lawn Contract – New contract does not have any increase to cost.

Chief advised they are doing a great job.

Motion to accept Sears and Son as landscaper for the Fire House. Motioned by C. Dowling 2nd by S. Yeomans APPROVED BY ALL

Chief advised that Sears & Son will deliver top soil as soon as the weather permits. Cost to spread the **top soil and seed** is \$245 and will be done as soon as weather permits.

Motion to spend \$245 to have Sears and Son provide top soil and spread it and seed on lawn Motioned by C. Dowling 2nd by M. Williams APPROVED BY ALL

B) Propane Usage – Chairman is still waiting for Nutmeg to contact him with day and time they will be out to check the propane system. It has been over 3-wks since he contacted them.

Commissioner Dowling will contact rep via his personal phone to set-up appointment. **Chairman** advised that depending upon how long it still may take to get them out here we might want to discuss changing contractors for service – to be discussed in June.

C) Doors – Overhead Door Company of Norwich provided a cost of \$1,120 to inspect all bay doors and door operators. Replace problems as needed. There may be extra fees incurred. The company also provide a maintenance and periodic inspection agreement that could be sign. Chairman suggested that the Commission wait to see how the repair of doors goes first and what exact cost it will be.

Motion to accept Overhead Door Company of Norwich proposed cost of \$1,120 to inspect all bay doors and door operators. Also understand additional fees may need to be paid above the \$1,120 original cost. Motioned by S. Yeomans 2nd by M. Williams APPROVED BY ALL

D) Painting – Chief advised painter is waiting for the weather to stop raining. Cost to paint doors and diesel tank is \$700.00. (Painting cost is on Chief's Spending Request)
