A) CIP Update - Tanker was approved by CIP - no goes to Finance Board

After "re-submitting" a new 10-yr Plan as requested by CIP

Commissioner Dowling - who is the Fire Commission Rep - was asked to re-submit

another one. His new 10-yr Plan shows:

1. 2019-2020 - Purchase New 3,000/gal Tanker Truck

\$411,418.00

2. 2023-2034 - Add Squad 115 Heavy Duty Rescue Pumper

\$750,000.00

3. 2026-2027 - Engine Tank 115: 2005 E-One Custom Pumper Refurbishment

\$275,000.00

Motion to accept the new changes to the 10-yr Plan and submit it to the CIP Commission. Motioned by S. Yeomans 2nd by M. Williams 4 APPROVED 1 ABSTAINED

B) 2019-2020 Budget Update – As of 3/4/19 the Fire Commission's Budget was tentatively approved with a 9% increase.

12 New Business:

A) Officers/EMS Payment – Chief Mike presented a proposal to the Selectmen that would pay (compensate) Officers and EMS personnel for "working" calls. The yearly cost right now for this pay (compensation) would be \$26,500. The Selectmen requested on 3/4/19 that the proposal to pay (compensate) Officers/EMS personnel be added to the Fire Commission's Budget – using separate Account Number(s). Adding this proposal to the Fire Commission's Budget would increase the bottom line amount from a 9% increase to around 31% increase.

After discussion – where a Commissioner did not like the compensation payment since we are a "Volunteer Department". Another Commissioner advised that as long as you explain why the budget is so high and what the pay (compensation) is and it would be kept separate all you can do is present it and see what the Selectmen and/or Towns people want to pay for.

Motion to add Chief's Mike's Proposal to pay (compensate) Officers and EMS personnel to the Fire Commission's 2019-2020 Budget.

Motioned by S. Yeomans 2nd by M. Williams 4 APPROVED 1 ABSTAINED
