8 Building and Grounds: A) Furnace Update – Received a quote from Nutmeg Mechanical Services to

furnish and install propylene glycol to existing boiler and pipes to help correct

propane expenditure issue. Quote price provided is - \$1,995.00

**B)** Alarm System – Air in furnace room was at a very dangerous level when inspector came in. He had a monitor on that measures levels and advised that he would be back when system was corrected. (returning 3/3/20 to complete inspection) Suggestion for monitoring was – Gas / Carbon Monoxide detectors to be added to system. Commissioner Williams will work to provide prices and information to add the needed monitoring to the system and will report back.

Chief's request for spending includes 14 items for the new Tanker that is being built. Items include – Nozzles, Hoses, Holly Pipe, Ground Cover Tarp, AC/DC
