Capital Improvement Projects Committee Regular Meeting, Thursday, March 16, 2023

Minutes

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:08 pm.
- Roll Call: Fred Oliver, Robert England, Ed Sarisley, Adrian Mandeville, Shannon Louden, Shawn Covell, Town Administrator Eric Anderson, Economic Development Committee representative Elaine Buchardt, Andover Fire Department Fire Chief Ron Mike.
- 3. Public Comment: none
- 4. Additions or Changes to the Agenda: none
- 5. Robert England moved to approve the minutes of the December 2022 meeting. Adrian Mandeville seconded the motion. Shannon Louden abstained from voting. The motion passed.
- 6. New Business
- a. We welcomed new Fire Commission representative Shawn Covell to the committee.
- b. Elaine Buchardt presented a proposal from the Economic Development Committee for "Welcome to Andover" signs to be placed at strategic locations around town. The proposal was for a large sign to be placed at a central point in town and smaller signs to be placed at town boundaries along Rt 6. The committee discussed several possibilities for sign details and placement, including adding a third smaller sign at the Hebron boundary along Rt 316. Adrian Mandeville made a motion to approve the purchase of a large sign, at a cost of \$4250, to be placed at a central location in town, with sign details and location to be determined by the EDC. Shannon Louden seconded the motion. Robert England abstained. The motion passed.

- c. Fire Commission representative Shawn Covell presented a request for purchase of a new rescue pumper for the Fire Department. The requested truck is a dual purpose vehicle that is expected to replace a pumper and a heavy rescue truck that are at the ends of their service lives. This purchase is included in the Fire Department's capital plan. Adrian Mandeville made a motion to support the purchase of the vehicle at a cost of \$1,050,000. Ed Sarisley seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous consent.
- 7. Public Comment: Ed Sarisley expressed the sadness felt by all at the passing of Curt Dowling, a valued member of the CIP committee who made many contributions to our town.
- 8. Adrian Mandeville moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:46 pm. Robert England seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous consent.
