It was brought to my attention that there has been clearing/grading taking place on your property at the above-referenced address. The work performed is adjacent to an intermittent watercourse and, as such, is considered a “regulated activity” under the town’s Inland Wetlands and Watercourse Regulations. More particularly, a “regulated activity” as defined by the town’s regulations “means any operation within or use of a wetland or watercourse involving removal or deposition of material, or any obstruction, alteration or pollution , of such wetland and watercourses, but shall not include the specified activities in Section 22a-40 of the Connecticut General Statutes. Furthermore, any clearing grubbing, filling, grading, paving,, excavating, constructing, depositing or removing of material and discharging of storm water on the land within the following upland review area is a regulated activity: Within 100 feet measured horizontally from the boundary of any other wetland or watercourse. Clearly the work performed on your property meets this definition.
