Subject: Violation of Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Regulations on property known as 122

US-6, Andover, Connecticut

The following activities have been observed to have occurred on your property located at 122 US-6, Andover, Connecticut:

- Timber Harvest within the 100-foot Upland Review Area of a wetland prior to jurisdictional ruling review by Andover Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Commission.
- Crossing of a wetland prior to jurisdictional ruling review by Andover Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Commission.

## **Applicable Laws and Regulations**

• Section 4.4 of the Andover Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Commission Regulations states that: To carry out the purposes of this section, any person proposing a permitted operation and use or a non-regulated operation and use shall, prior to commencement of such operation and use, notify the Commission on a form provided by it, and provide the Agency with sufficient information to enable it to properly determine that the proposed operation and use is a permitted or nonregulated use of a wetland or watercourse. The Commission shall rule that the proposed operation and use or portion of it is a permitted or non-regulated operation and use or that the proposed operation and use is a regulated activity and a permit is required.

Order

You are hereby ordered to cease and desist from any further regulated activities within regulated areas or within one hundred (100') feet of a regulated area, specifically including, but not limited to, the

cutting of trees or vegetation and the construction or deposition of any other structure or material.

For each day during which the violation continues, upon submission is approved but not implemented, shall subject you to a civil penalty of not more than one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars per day for such

violation.
