Harvest Plan outline:

With two wet areas located behind the yellow house next door and in the lower right area, these areas can be easily avoided. Skid trails already in place go around these areas.

A long vernal pool that does not flow anywhere is next to the 4x4 road and is easily avoided.

No crossings of any wet areas are planned or necessary.

With planned winter harvest conditions ground damage of any kind may be avoided.

As outlined in the attached foresters report there will be a harvest of mature trees of several species. Also some thinning of poorer stock and the birch and beech undergrowth. Lastly several dead oaks from Gypsy moth attack will be culled.
