- 5. <u>New Business:</u>

a. Application of Curt Dowling, 389 Lake Road/Lot 152. Request to stabilize lake front Property with the installation of a rip-rap lake wall. (Application details e-mailed to Commission Members and available in the Building Dept.) **John England** reads Item 5a and then asks Mr. Dowling to explain the Application.

Curt Dowling explains how the Lake front on his property is eroding and his plan to construct a Lake front wall to help prevent this. He states that both ALMA and ALPO have approved this. Mr. Dowling presents pictures of the property including a picture of a tree that is falling in the Lake due to the erosion. He notes that there is one change in the application; he till install stone stairs instead of cement stairs.

John Valente asks how far the stairs will extend into the Lake

Curt Dowling states that they extend the same amount as presented on the application

John Valente asks Mr. Dowling who the contractor/sub-contractor is doing the work?

Brief discussion on Mr. Dowlings Contractors however John Valente is confident that they know what the Town is looking for on the Lake. Continued discussion on the scope of work that will be done on the Lakefront, the property and the erosion that has occurred.

Curt Dowling notes that ALMA prefers a rip rap wall over a concrete one

Discussion on rip rap vs concrete walls

John Valente asks the Commission Members if they would like to have a site walk and he recommends that they do all three application at once since the properties are in close proximity of each other.

John England sets the Site Walk for all three properties on November 11th starting at 9:30 AM

b. Application of John and Janice Benda, 157 Lakeside Drive. Request to repair a cement retaining wall on the lake-shore.. (Application details e-mailed to Commission Members and available in the Building Dept.)

Discussion on the Benda application for a Lake wall repair/replacement.

John Valente has no issues with any impact on the wetlands for this repair to take place.
