- 8. Agent Report/Enforcement Actions Wetlands Agent Joe Wagner gave updates on the following:
  - a. May 10, 2023- Agent approval of #IWWC 23-05: Eric Anderson (Town of Andover), 17 School Road-Construction of an approximately 75-foot-by-33-foot Community Garden and removal of approximately 0.15 acres of trees. trees cleared, added fill, leveled ground, removed old pile of topsoil, graded and seeded
  - April 26, 2023- Agent approval of #IWWC 23-04: Connecticut Meditation Center, Inc., 131 U.S. Route
    6- Construction of an approximately 7-foot-by-5-foot statue and construction of an approximately 18-foot-by-18-foot wooden structure to cover the statue. applied for permit (temporary)
  - c. April 12, 2023- Agent approval of #IWWC 23-03: Sean Maynard, 196 Lake Road Demolition of an approximately 20-foot-by20-foot one-car garage, and construction of a 24-foot-by-30-foot two-car garage in the same location. homeowner working with Jim Hallisey on dry well
  - d. March 13, 2023- Agent approval of #IWWC 23-02: Andrea Gaines, 115 Lakeside Drive- Removal and reconstruction of an 80-ft long x 3-ft high masonry wall, and a 52-ft long x 4-ft high masonry wall. – walls being rebuilt
