Mike:

Scott Beebe has requested a modification to an existing Special Permit so as to operate a dog training facility at 241 Route 6. The operation involves specialized training for working dogs. His specialty appears to be dogs for canine units and similar operations. The application did in fact secure an approval to operate a kennel on the Post Farm in the vicinity of Hutchinson Road. The facility that was approved was never built but training has been going on elsewhere on the Post Farm. The current application is seeking to essentially modify the approval for the original application so as to legitimize the operation in the eyes of the Town and State for compliance purposes.

As part of the Planning and Zoning Commission's Special Permit/Site Plan review process I am reaching out to you as Fire Marshal to review the plan which is on file at the Planning and Zoning Commission's web-page on the Town of Andover's web-site. For the sake of clarity, the current request involves the property accessed directly from Route 6.

The matter is slated to go before the PZC at their 9.20.21 meeting.
