1. <u>Call to Order</u> Robert Hamburger calls the Meeting to order at 7:06PM

4. Open Public Hearing on:

Robert Hamburger opens the Public Hearing at 7:08PM.

a. Application of Joshua Clark, 35 Riverside Drive, Home Occupation Special Permit under Section 23 Special Permit and Section 4.12.A(2)iii Home Occupation to have a business with 6 employees.

John Valente informs the Commission what information that was still required from Mr. Clark has now been provided to the Commission, the Town Sanitarian, the Fire Marshall and the Wetlands Agent have all submitted letters of approval for the application. He discusses these letters and the document submitted by Mr. Clark that addresses other issues that were raised at the last meeting (attachment

#1). John reads this document to the Board and discusses each Item in detail (waiver requests 23 2B/4 site plan and 23 2B/6 parking, ENS Plan, Outdoor Lighting and Bridge Guard Rail)

Josh Clark clarifies the sketch that he provided to Mr. Valente on the Bridge Guard Rail,

John Valente briefly discusses the design however he finds is acceptable. He then shows the Commission the turn around on the property that he showed to Curt Dowling and the Fire Marshall who both confirmed would be ample space to turn around and that the parking area is acceptable. John then reads sections of the letter from Attorney O'Brien (attachment #2).

Discussion on the letter and the verbiage about the Easement.

John Valente reads the Easement Agreement to the Commission (on file in the Building Dept.). He mentions next what is still required prior the a CO being granted (grading of the driveway and the railings). John then outlines the process that an application for a home based business is conducted and how Mr. Clark proceeded.

- Dark sky/shielded lighting/LED compliant
- Prior to being granted a CO the applicant must provide an as build garage building plan and driveway grades.
- As built should include the finished parking areas showing the private parking areas and the loading spots
- No motor vehicle repair/oil changes on the property
- Re-inspection within 90 days
- Hours of operation to be Mon-Fri: 7:30AM-5PM and Sat 7:30AM-1PM

The Commission would also like each revision of the Regulations clearly noted so that they are sure the correct version is being adopted

- 12.8.3 after 12.8.3.2 Should be 12.8.4
- 12.8.4 should be 12.8.5
