Food bottles & jars

Aerosol containers (food grade only)

Aluminum foil

Cans & bottles

Foil containers

Metal lids from cans & bottles Aerosol containers (deodorizers, cleaners, pesticides, etc.)

Foil tops from yogurt containers

Paint cans

Pots & pans

Small pieces of scrap metal

Spiral wound containers

Plastic bottles (with or without caps attached)

Plastic containers, tubs & lids

Plastic one-use cups (no lids, no straws)

Loose bottle caps

Plastic bags & wrap

Plastic plates, bowls & utensils

Prescription bottles

Single-use coffee containers

Styrofoam cups, containers & packaging peanuts
